Textual, graphic, 1907-1979, predominant 1910-1931, 0.20 m

This fonds consists of personal records of the MacLeod family of Lytton and Kamloops, B.C. Most of the records consist of letters of condolence received by Mabel Beatrice MacLeod following the death of her husband Ewen MacLeod, a respected Indian Agent, on September 27, 1931. Also included are three photograph albums from approximately 1910 to 1934 containing views of family and friends, Kamloops and surrounding areas, and the Tranquille Sanatorium.
