Title: Trevor Schubert fonds

Dates of creation: 1876 – 2013, predominant 1970 – 2010

Physical description: 0.74 m of textual records, cartographic records, and graphic material

Biographical sketch:

Trevor Earl Schubert was born on 4 February 1922 at Armstrong, British Columbia, the son of Augustus Schubert, whose grandparents were British Columbia pioneers Catherine and Francis Augustus Schubert, part of the Overlanders that journeyed by land from Fort Garry (now Winnipeg) to Kamloops in 1862. Trevor Schubert graduated from high school in 1941 and joined the Royal Air Force. During the Second World War he served as a pilot officer in the Royal Canadian Air Force and flew on 45 missions with Bomber Command. He married Jean Emeny of Enderby, BC, on 16 August 1944. In the early 1950's the couple lived in Vernon before settling in Kamloops where they raised their children Carol, Marion, and Ken. Trevor Schubert worked for the provincial sales tax office in Kamloops from 1954 to 1981. In his later years he devoted much of his time to genealogical research on the Schubert family and the history of the Overlanders. He died 29 May 2010 at Kamloops.

Scope and content:

The fonds consists of genealogical records, research notes, photographs, clippings, and military records accumulated by Trevor Schubert between approximately 1970 and 2010. The records primarily document the genealogy of the Schubert family that arrived in Kamloops with the Overlanders of 1862. Also included are records documenting the ancestral lines of Trevor Schubert and his military service as a RCAF pilot officer in the Second World War. Most of the records were compiled and maintained by Trevor Schubert in a series of numbered binders. The fonds has been divided into two series: genealogy of the Schubert family and military.

Series 1: Genealogy of the Schubert family

1876-2013. — 0.60 m of textual records, maps, and graphic material.

This series consists of records created, accumulated, and compiled by Trevor Schubert between approximately 1970 and 2010 while he was conducting research into his ancestral lines and the genealogy of the Schubert family, an early British Columbia settler family that arrived in Kamloops with the Overlanders of 1862. The records were maintained by Trevor Schubert in 19 numbered binders that document various areas of his genealogical research, including the Overlanders, Catherine and Augustus Schubert and their descendents (other family names include but are not limited to LeDuc, Swanson, Hoey, Fraser, Timberlake), Hat Creek House, the Schubert home at Otter Lake, Schubert family reunions, and the Overlanders memorial sculpture erected in Kamloops in 2003. The binders include genealogical research notes, copies of legal records, a chronology of the Schubert family, photographs, maps, clippings, correspondence, copies of articles and reminiscences, and copies of official documents. Also included is part of a Hat Creek House account book (1876-1878), an extensive Schubert – O'Hare family tree, a small number of original photographs of Catherine and Augustus Schubert, and Augustus Schubert II, and 1 photograph album that belonged to Gladys Schubert, who was married to Augustus III.

Graphic material includes ca. 400 b&w photographs and ca. 310 col. photographs.

Series 2: Military

1941-[ca. 2005]. — 0.14 m of textual records and graphic material.

This series consists of military records, clippings, articles, photographs, and notes documenting Trevor Schubert's service in the Second World War. Most of the records were collected and maintained by Schubert in three binders he compiled between approximately 1970 and 2005. The binders include research material and photographs documenting his activities during the war as well as clippings, pamphlets, and photographs related to RCAF reunions, fellow RCAF crew members, and various veterans of the Second World War from the Kamloops region.

Graphic material includes ca. 190 b&w photographs and ca. 30 col. photographs.
