Biographical Sketch:

Edward C.H. Thomas was a photographer who succeeded W.R. Lang in running the Royal Studio on Victoria Street in Kamloops, B.C. in 1898. Thomas left Kamloops for Washington State in September 1901 to operate a farm.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of Edward C.H. Thomas' photographs, mostly taken in and around the Kamloops area with a large portion of photographs depicting a Passion Play put on by a group of First Nations people on the Kamloops Indian Reserve.

Custodial History:

Initial collection of photographs was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by E. Thomas at an unknown date. Additional photographs donated by other donors not part of significant collections have been accrued to this collection. See individual items and accession records for more information.
