Title: Wood and Tunstall fonds

Dates of Creation: 1888-1902

Physical Description: 12 cm of textual records and 1 map

Administrative History:

Wood and Tunstall was a firm in Kamloops, B.C. which imported and sold general merchandise. Wentworth F. Wood and James C. Tunstall acquired the business from J.A. Mara in 1890, after having previously co-managed the store. In 1893 the partnership dissolved and J.A. Mara repossessed the store and stock was auctioned off.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of two ledgers of accounts for Wood and Tunstall, which cover their operations of the business as well as some time prior to and after their ownership. Fonds also contains an index to an unknown ledger, correspondence, an invoice, an envelope, and a map of property in Victoria, B.C.

Custodial History:

Accessions 0.2849, 0.2856, 0.2865 were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives at an unknown time by an unknown donor. Materials were formerly placed in the Vertical Files Collection.
