Biographical Sketch:

Hewitt Bostock was born on May 31, 1864 in Walton-on-the-Hill, England, the son of Samuel and Marian Bostock. Bostock was schooled at a boarding school in Brighton, England, before entering Trinity College at Cambridge to study law in 1882. In 1885 Bostock would graduate Trinity College with an honours degree in mathematics, before being called to the bar at Lincoln's Inn in 1888. Bostock would not settle down to practice law, though, as he would spend the rest of the year travelling with his friend E.J. Hopkins through North America, Australia, China, and Japan before coming to the Thompson Valley in British Columbia. On May 19, 1888 he purchased the property of Jacob Duck in Monte Creek, known as the Duck and Pringle Ranch, but he would not permanently move to Canada until 1893. Before emigrating, Bostock would marry Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie in 1890, with whom he had five daughters (Marian Noel, Ethel Jean, Annie E., Septima Jessie, and Ada Ruth) and three sons (Alexander Hewitt, Hugh Samuel, and William Norman). The family first settled in Canada in Victoria, B.C., where Bostock would start the Weekly Province (later the Province) newspaper in 1884 and enter Federal politics as the Liberal candidate for the Yale-Cariboo riding. In 1895 Bostock would be elected the President of the Kamloops Agricultural Association, while continuing political campaigning for the election of 1896. Bostock would see success in this election, and the same year he would expand his newspapering business with the purchase of the Inland Sentinel from Spink, Finbow and Jones. 1897 saw Bostock become even more involved in local matters in Kamloops, becoming the president of the Tranquille Hydraulic Co. (built on the water debentures that he had purchased in 1895) and rebuilding the popular local entertainment venue Raven's Hall. In 1904 Bostock would be appointed to the Senate, and would rise to act as Leader of the Senate for the Liberal Party in 1914, Federal minister for Public Works from 1921-1922, the Speaker of the Senate from 1922-1930, and a representative of Canada at the Sixth Assembly of the League of Nations in 1925. Bostock's last major political appointment before his death came in 1927, as the Chairman of a Special Joint Committee on the claims of BC Indian Tribes. During his lifetime Bostock was involved with a variety of social and business organizations, such as the Kootenay Lumber Company (founder), the first Golf Club in Victoria (co-founder), the British Columbia Printing and Lithographing Co., Ltd. (president), the Monte Creek Trading Co., Ltd. (president), the Royal Colonial Institute, the Royal Agricultural Society of England, the British Empire League, the Canadian Forestry Association, the Rideau Club, the Freemasons, the Alpine Club, and St. John's Ambulance (president). He is also notable for building the Monte Creek Anglican Church of St. Peter's in memory of his son Captain Alex H. Bostock (who was killed in action during WWI) and Mount Hewitt Bostock in the Stoyoma Range was named after him. Hewitt Bostock died on April 29, 1930 at Monte Creek, BC at the age of 65.

Lizzie Jean McCombie Bostock (nee Cowie) was born in 1867 in London, England, the daughter of Hugh Cowie and Septima Wariters. She married Hewitt Bostock in June 1890 in Kingston, England, with whom she had five daughters (Marian Noel, Ethel Jean, Annie E., Septima Jessie, and Ada Ruth) and three sons (Alexander Hewitt, Hugh Samuel, and William Norman). In 1893 the family emigrated to Canada, and split their time between Victoria and the Bostock Ranch property in Monte Creek. Bostock was active in maintaining the ranch until her death on January 5, 1942 in Saanich, BC.

Marian Noel Sherman (nee Bostock) was born on December 25, 1891 in Walton-on-the-Hill, England, the daughter of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. She studied at the London School of Medicine, earning her MD in 1917 and later passing her exams to become a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons in 1921. During World War I she served as a house physician at the Queen's Hospital for Children in Hackney and as a house surgeon at St. George's Hospital in London. After the war, she travelled to India to work as a missionary doctor, remaining there until 1934. While in India she met and married banker Victor Sherman on May 23, 1928. In 1935 the couple retired to Victoria, BC, where Sherman became involved in various social causes such as mental health, women's rights, and peace. She was also an avowed atheist and humanist, becoming one of the founders of the Victorian Humanist Fellowship and the Humanist Association of Canada. In 1975 she was named the Canadian Humanist of the Year. Marian Noel Sherman (nee Bostock) died on August 18, 1975 in Victoria, BC at the age of 83.

Alexander Hewitt Bostock was born on January 16, 1893 in Epsom, England, the son of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. He attended Harvey's School in Vancouver and then prep schools in England before enrolling in Kingston Military College. There he graduated with honours and with a prize for riding, and went on to study electrical engineering at McGill University. During the summers he worked on a survey team for the Pacific Great Eastern Railway, and when war was declared in 1914 he enlisted with the 31st BC Horse. Bostock was then transferred to the Strathcona Horse and became a captain with the Canadian Mounted Rifles. Alexander Hewitt Bostock died on July 26, 1916 at the age of 23 leading a drive to Pozières, France. St. Peter's Anglican Church in Monte Creek, BC was built in his honour.

Ethel Jean Bostock was born on July 18, 1894 in Esquimalt, BC, the daughter of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. She was educated at Miss Smith's school in Ottawa and Crofton House in Vancouver before spending two years at Prior's Field in Godalming, England. During World War I she worked for the Voluntary Aid Detachment in Ottawa before joining the Women's Auxiliary Corps in England as a chauffeur for Army Officers. After the war she studied agriculture at the University of Redding, and graduated with a BSc in 1921. Bostock then returned to Canada and was active in running the family ranch in Monte Creek. She also acted as a representative for the Monte Creek area on the board of School District 24. Ethel Jean Bostock died on September 9, 1960 in Monte Creek, BC at the age of 66.

Annie E. (Nan) Bostock was born on September 14, 1896 in Godalming, England, the daughter of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. She was educated for 3 years in England as a teenager, and upon the death of her father in 1930 she assumed responsibility for the operations of Bostock Ranch in Monte Creek. Bostock became well known in the ranching community, and was active with the local Beekeepers Association where she acted as president in 1921. With the assistance of E.P. Coles and Fred Nichol as foremen, she would continue to run

the Bostock Ranch until its sale in 1962. A portion of the property was retained by her, where she continued to raise a small herd of cattle and keep bees. Bostock was also an avid painter, and was active in the Canadian Red Cross Society, SPCA, 4-H Club, Canadian Girl Guide Association, and the Kamloops Historical Society. Annie E. Bostock died on September 27, 1970 in Kamloops, BC at the age of 74.

Hugh Samuel Bostock was born on January 6, 1901 in Vancouver, BC, the son of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. Bostock was educated in Ottawa, England, and Vancouver before attending the Royal Military College in 1917. He then began studying at McGill University, graduating with an MSc in Mining Engineering in 1926, and going on to earn a PhD in Geology from Wisconsin University in 1929. In 1930 he joined the Geological Survey of Canada after spending a number of summer doing field work with them, and was appointed to work in charge of a geological and topographical exploration of the Yukon territory and act as the resident mining engineer. Bostock did not live year round in the Yukon, but spent the following 3 decades travelling to various field parties in the Yukon and British Columbia. For his work in the field he was appointed to the Canadian Board on Geographical Names, a governor of the Arctic Institute of North America, a Fellow of the Geological Society of America, and the Royal Society of Canada. Other honours he received include having the *Claytonia Bostockii* flower and the H.S. Bostock Core Library for the Department of Indian Affairs in Whitehorse named for him, and being presented with the Massey Medal by the Royal Canadian Geographical Society. Bostock was married to Violet Craigie Hamilton, with whom he had two daughters (Joan Marion and Nan Isabelle) and two sons (Hewitt Hamilton and Charles Alexander). He later retired to Ottawa. Hugh Samuel Bostock died on February 1, 1994 in Ottawa, ON at the age of 93.

Brigadier-General William Norman Bostock was born on November 12, 1903 in Monte Creek, BC, the son of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. He was educated at the Monte Creek School and at the Hilbourne Sisters' school in Ottawa before spending his teenage years in England at Hillside and Charterhouse prep schools during World War I. In 1919 Bostock returned to Canada and enrolled in Trinity College for a year, before entering the Royal Military College where he graduated with honours in 1924. He then earned a BSc in Civil Engineering from McGill University, enrolling directly in the 4th year of the program and graduating in 1925. Bostock then gained employment with the National Topographical Survey as a Dominion Land Surveyor, as well as worked on the family ranch in Monte Creek. In March 1929 he married Margaret Peggy Nichols at Monte Creek, with whom he had one son (William) and two daughters (Mollie and Susan). The family lived at the Ned's Creek ranch until Bostock joined the army in 1930. Bostock went on to serve in India and was made Deputy Assistant to the Adjutant-General of National Defence Headquarter in Ottawa in 1939. During World War II he was sent overseas and was appointed Deputy Assistant to the 2nd Division in 1940, during which time he earned a CBE, and was promoted to Brigadier-General of Pacific Command by 1943. After the war he travelled to China with Victor Odium, then Canadian Ambassador to China. Upon Bostock's retirement from the military in 1947, he purchased Ned's Creek Ranch and settled permanently in the area. He was involved in a variety of community and business organizations, predominantly the BC Federation of Agriculture, the BC Beef Cattle Growers Association, and Provincial Winter Fair Committee, the Royal Canadian Legion, and School District 24. William Norman Bostock died on November 8, 1970 in England during a trip at the age of 67.

Septima Jessie Bostock was born on October 6, 1905 in Monte Creek, BC, the daughter of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. She died on December 29, 1906 in Monte Creek, BC at the age of 1 after contracting bronchial pneumonia.

Ada Ruth Fallis (nee Bostock) was born on January 29, 1910 in Ottawa, ON, the daughter of Hewitt Bostock and Lizzie Jean McCombie Cowie. She was educated at the Monte Creek School and a number of private schools in Vancouver and England. In 1928 she enrolled in an arts program at the University of British Columbia, graduating in 1932. She then trained for 2 years with the Mothercraft Society in London, gaining a diploma with honours, and studied Occupational Therapy in Toronto. She interned with the Toronto Psychiatric Hospital, the Hamilton Sanatorium for Tuberculosis, and the Toronto General Hospital. On September 21, 1938 she married Dr. Albert Murray Fallis in Toronto, with whom she would have three sons (Bruce William, Alex, and Hugh). Ada Ruth Fallis (nee Bostock) died on November 16, 2001 in Ottawa, ON at the age of 91.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of various records created and collected by the Bostock Family.

Custodial History:

Records were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by various members of the Bostock family at various points in time, as follows. Some records (where noted) were integrated into the Rare Books collection, Map collection, Photograph collection, Directories collection, and Vertical Files collection, before being brought together as a distinct collection during reprocessing in 2022. Accessions #0.2733, #0.2878, and #0.3660 were donated in 1960 by Ethel Jean and Annie E. Bostock, and were previously placed in the Vertical Files collection. Accessions #0.2734, #0.2736, and #0.2738 were donated at an unknown time by the Bostock Family, and were previously placed in the Vertical Files collection. Accession #0.2735 was donated in 1963 by Annie E. Bostock, and was previously placed in the Vertical Files collection. Accessions #0.2737 and #0.2739 have no available donor information, and were previously placed in the Vertical Files collection. Accession #1963.095 was donated on September 27, 1963 by Miss Bostock via Des Vicars, and were previously placed in the Map collection. Accession #1973.052 was donated on June 9, 1973 by the Bostock Estate via Ada Ruth Fallis, with some materials initially being catalogued as the School District No. 23 fonds and others being integrated into the Photograph collection and Map collection. Accession #1974.022 was donated on April 16, 1974 by the Bostock Estate via Mrs. Fallis. Accession #1974.033 was donated on July 2, 1974 by the Bostock Estate via Hugh Fallis, with some materials initially being placed in the Map collection. Accession #1982.090 was donated in October 1982 by John Weller for the Cariboo College Library, and some materials were previously placed in the Vertical Files and Rare Books collection. Accessions #2018.012, #2018.057, #2018.072, and #2020.040 were donated by Hugh Fallis on January 15, 2018, July 26, 2018, August 15, 2018, and November 27, 2020, respectively. Accession #2018.216 was donated on May 28, 2016 by Brett Bostock.

Scope and Content: Series contains records relating to the Bostock Ranch (also known as the Monte Creek Ranch), located in Monte Creek near Kamloops, B.C. The series is predominantly made of up yearly file records containing correspondence and financial records; ranch ledgers recording financial information and employee records; and ranch diaries kept by E.P. Coles, the long-time manager of the Bostock Ranch. Series also contains various financial records, notebooks, plans for the ranch property, legislation, inventories and valuations of the ranch property, and water rights information for Monte Creek and Neds Creek.

Records in files 2018.012.016, 2018.012.019, 2018.012.026, 2018.072.006, 2018.072.010, 2018.072.012, 2018.072.015, 2018.072.016, 2018.072.017, 2018.072.020, 2018.072.021, 2018.072.024, 2018.072.026, and 2018.072.027 are restricted, as they contain Personal Information.
