Biographical Sketch:

Harry Warren Campbell was born on April 28, 1877 in Acadia Mines, Nova Scotia, the son of David H. Campbell and Margaret Grant. In 1888 the family came to Kamloops, B.C. Campbell was active in the music community in Kamloops, being at various times a member of the Pioneer Band, the Kamloops Band, the Rocky Mountain Rangers Band, and Campbell's Orchestra. He was also a member of the Knights of Pythias, the Canadian Legion, and the Elk's Lodge. During World War I, Campbell served overseas with Tobin's Tigers. Harry Warren Campbell died on June 6, 1963 in Kamloops, B.C. at the age of 86.

Scope and Content:

Collection consists of black and white photographs collected by Harry Warren Campbell during his time in Kamloops. Photographs are predominantly of musical bands of which Campbell was a member.

Custodial History:

Accession #1937.026 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives at an unknown date by Harry Warren Campbell, possibly prior to 1964.
