Biographical Sketch:

Abraham Jagoe was born in November 1861 in Ireland, the son of Reverend Abraham Jagoe (sr) and Mary Moore. Jagoe enlisted with the 5th Battalion of the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, rising to the rank of Captain and serving during the Boer War. He came to British Columbia around 1910, following his brother John Thomas Broderick Jagoe, and settled in the Kamloops region to work as a rancher. While in Kamloops, Jagoe was also active in local politics, being a major supporter of mayoral candidate J.T. Robinson during his campaign. Abraham Jagoe died on February 14th, 1922 in Kamloops, BC at the age of 60.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of military certificates for Abraham Jagoe, and a certificate of ordination for his father, Reverend Abraham Jagoe (sr).

Custodial History:

Accession #1975.050 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on August 5, 1975 by Mrs. Fred Nichol, the daughter of John Thomas Broderick Jagoe and niece of Abraham Jagoe. Records were formerly placed in the Vertical Files collection before being brought together as a distinct fonds during reprocessing in 2021.
