Biographical Sketch:

Carell McPherson was born on May 21, 1933. She married Norman McPherson, with whom she had one daughter (Karen) and one son (Allan). Carell McPherson died on November 25, 2011 in North Vancouver, BC at the age of 78.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of various records collected by Carell McPherson, connected to her life in Kamloops. Records include photographs, postcards, souvenirs, and gathered history materials.

Custodial History:

Accessions were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by Carell McPherson on the following dates: accession #1969.107 on October 15, 1969 and accession #1987.027 on April 24, 1987. Both sets of records were previously integrated into the Vertical Files Collection, the Kamloops Directories collection, and the Photograph collection based on format, before being brought together as a distinct fonds during reprocessing in 2021.
