Biographical Sketch:

Willson E. Knowlton was an optometrist from Ontario, who lived in British Columbia, the Yukon, and Alaska. Knowlton was involved in many community groups, notably the Kamloops Little Theatre Company and the Kamloops Museum Association, and was an avid historian. Knowlton died in 1982.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of the books and personal papers of Willson E. Knowlton, which includes papers related to his optometry practice, administrative papers of the Kamloops Little Theatre Company and general theatre materials, administrative papers of the Kamloops Museum Association, Knowlton's personal research on various topics, and maps.

Custodial History

This collection was initially comprised of materials from accession 1983.039. Books and pamphlets were initially removed from the collection and placed in the Rare Books Collection. They were returned to this collection (as well as remained listed in the Rare Books Collection) during reprocessing in 2018. Additional materials were accrued to the collection during reprocessing in 2018, 2019, and 2022, which were formerly placed in the Map Collection and Vertical Files Collection.

Accession 1983.039 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by Mrs. Grace Swarson, the sister of W.E. Knowlton on behalf of the estate of Willson E. Knowlton, in March 1983. The remainder of accessions were donated by Willson E. Knowlton as follows: 0.2700 on May 16, 1977;
