**Title:** Lawrence Bauman fonds

### Biographical Sketch:

**Lawrence Bauman** was born in 1889 to Alfred Bauman and wife in Kamloops. He wrote for Kamloops newspapers and was very interested in the history of the Kamloops area, which prompted him to strike up a correspondence with Mary Balf in the 1970s, the first archivist of the Kamloops Museum and Archives. He married Rose Winnifred Bauman in 1914 in Kamloops, and later moved their family to Oregon where he was active in many community organizations, such as the Western Forest Industries Association and Elks Club.

### Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of Lawrence Bauman's personal papers, comprised largely of correspondence with Mary Balf (curator of the Kamloops Museum & Archives) regarding his research and historical writings about the Kamloops area. Fonds also includes essays, poetry, and newspaper articles written by Bauman, early photographs of Kamloops and a souvenir book of views of Kamloops, newspaper clippings, and a deed for a cemetery plot in Oregon.
