Biographical Sketch:

Jessie Playfair Bickford (nee Lees) was born in Ontario in August 1896, the daughter of Andrew G. Lees and Mary G. Lees. She married Charles W. Bickford of Kamloops, BC, and was a poet and teacher. She died in Kamloops on May 9, 1998 at age 101.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of publications which contain Jessie Bickford's poetry, a scrapbook, and a small amount of miscellaneous material.

Custodial History:

Accessions 1986.055 and 1985.048 were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives in 1986 and on August 27, 1985 (respectively) by Mary Beth Plommer, at the request of Jessie Bickford.

Accession 1979.040 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on July 31, 1979 by Jessie Bickford.

Fonds was originally comprised of 1986.055, with 1985.048 and 1979.040 being accrued by the Archivist during reprocessing in 2018.
