Biographical Sketch:

Kathleen Kay Bingham was born on September 11, 1903 in Ontario. Shortly after her birth her family moved to Lloydminster, Alberta, where she attended school until grade 8. After her mother died, Bingham moved to Barnhartvale in Kamloops, B.C. to live with her aunt, and graduated high school from the Kamloops High School. Bingham attended university in Vancouver in 1918, and enrolled in the Victoria Normal School the following year to pursue a career in teaching. She was granted a Class 'A' Teaching Certificate in 1920, and was soon hired at the rural Adelphi School in Westwold, B.C. In 1921 she transferred to the Barnhartvale School, where she worked for 5 and a half years. 1928 saw her move to Kamloops to work briefly at Allan Matthews School before moving to Lloyd George, where she would remain until the mid-1950s. She then taught at George Hilliard School until her retirement on June 24, 1965. Two years after her retirement a new elementary school in Brocklehurst, would be named in her honour: the Kay Bingham Elementary School. Kathleen Kay Bingham died in August 1995 in Kamloops, B.C., at the age of 92.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of two stock certificates, an album of photograph prints of British Columbia, and three tintype photographs.

Custodial History:

Accessions 1966.106 and 1966.116 were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by Kathleen Kay Bingham on July 2 and July 7, 1966, respectively. Materials were originally placed in the Vertical Files Collection and Photograph Collection prior to processing in 2019.
