The Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Enginemen was established in 1873 as a mutual benefit society and trade union for workers employed as railway firemen, expanding its mandate to include railroad engineers in 1907. In 1967 they merged with the Order of Railway Conductors and Brakemen, the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, and the Switchmen's Union of North America to form the United Transportation Union.
