Biographical Sketch:

Guy Collings was born in Chudleigh, England, on July 18, 1890, the son of Charles John and Melora Collings. When Guy and his brother were teenagers the family emigrated to Canada, landing first in Sicamous, B.C., before spending a brief period in Kelowna. At the behest of Charles John Collings' interest in the Seymour Arms Fruit Lands, the family soon settled in Seymour Arm, where they would build a Tudor style mansion and cultivate a lavish English-style estate on their homestead. Guy and his brother worked at various occupations in Seymour Arm, including logging, construction, bee keeping, and running a fruit cannery as the Collings Bros. Guy would also become a skilled furniture maker, and is credited with constructing the majority of the furnishings for their mansion. Guy also served with the CEF during World War I. Later in life Guy would give historical tours of the family property, and would attempt to have it made into a local museum. Guy Collings died in 1976.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of two maps of the area near Seymour Arm and labels from jam packaged by Collings Bros.

Custodial History:

Accession 0.3079 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives in 1961 by R.B.A. Cragg for Guy Collings.
