Administrative History:

The Diamond Jubilee 1953 Committee was an organization formed in Kamloops to help organize events and raise funds for the Diamond Jubilee celebration, held in Kamloops, B.C. from May 31-June 3, 1953. The organization held their inaugural meeting on February 18, 1953 at City Hall, and folded operations later that year. Events for the celebration included a ceremony marking the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II, sports tournaments, parades, musical concerts, a pioneer reunion luncheon, a Children's festival, and fireworks display.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records from the Diamond Jubilee Committee related to the organization and promotion of the celebrations. Records include meeting minutes, financial records, correspondence, brochures and promotional material, and a list of Kamloops pioneers.

Custodial History:

Accession 1966.212 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on November 16, 1966 by Mrs. E.J. Maloney, the chairman of the Diamond Jubilee Committee.
