#### Biographical Sketch:

Patrick Henry/Herbert Docksteader was born on July 10, 1878 near Cork, Ireland. He came to San Francisco, USA with his father at the age of 9, but left home at age 14 to avoid entering the bricklayers trade in his father's footsteps. Docksteader travelled throughout the western United States, eventually coming to British Columbia in 1896. He would not stay in B.C. long, though, and would follow the prospecting routes north to Alaska. Docksteader travelled extensively during this period, working odd jobs and mining intermittently. Around 1907 he returned to B.C. on a permanent basis, taking up residence at Tranquille Creek to pursue mining claims in the area. While working his semi-successful mining claims, Docksteader also worked as a plumber for McKinnon Plumbing and as a logger. During the final year of World War I, he would enlist with the C.E.F., serving in France with the 29th Battalion before the war's end. After the war, Docksteader returned to Kamloops and took up his former occupation of mining at Tranquille. In 1965 Docksteader retired to the Provincial Home in Kamloops, B.C., where he lived until contracting an unknown illness which precluded him being sent for treatment at Shaughnessy Hospital in Vancouver, B.C. Patrick Henry/Herbert Docksteader died on March 28, 1967 in Vancouver, B.C., at the age of 88.

#### **Scope and Content:**

Fonds consists of the personal records of P.H. Docksteader. Records include licenses and identification correspondence, a union dues booklet, general correspondence and records related to Docksteader's mining activities, brands and horses, finances, and health.

#### **Custodial History:**

Accession 1974.005 was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on January 17, 1974 by the Docksteader Estate per Mr. Willie at the Provincial Home. Accession 0.2712 was donated at an unknown date by the Provincial Home per R.B.A. Cragg, and was presumably part of the Docksteader Estate. Both accessions were previously placed separately into the Vertical Files collection, and were brought together during reprocessing of collection in 2019.
