Scope and Content:

Collection consists of subject files relating to First Nations topics for Kamloops and the surrounding area.

Custodial History:

Collection was compiled by Karen Aird and KMA Staff from various sources, including subject files, newspapers, and archival collections. Collection was reprocessed in 2019 to include accession information for specific items and to correct inconsistencies.
