Biographical Sketch:

Herbert Gardiner was born on March 9, 1891 at Trowbridge, England. Herbert would enlist in the Army, and served during World War I with the 48th Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Forces. He married Edith Mary Jordan at St. Luke's Church in Deptford on September 16, 1916. After the war the couple moved to Canada, landing first in St. John's, Newfoundland on March 29, 1920 and then settling in Kamloops on April 3, 1920. Upon coming to Kamloops Herbert would take up a position at the city courthouse, working there for 34 years as a serviceman until his retirement in 1956. Herbert would be an active member of the Kamloops branch of the Royal Canadian Legion (Lodge no. 52) and the Mount St. Paul Masonic Lodge (no. 109), and in 1970 Herbert would gain his Canadian Citizenship. During their life in Kamloops, Herbert and Edith would retain close ties to their extended family in England, receiving numerous postcards and photographs. Herbert Gardiner died in 1982 at age 91.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of materials from the estate of Herbert Gardiner. Fonds is comprised primarily of family photographs of the Gardiner's extended family and of Herbert's and his wife Edith's time in Kamloops. Fonds also contains the personal records of Herbert Gardiner, including materials related to the social and professional organizations he was involved with, Canadian citizenship documents, financial records, family history, and small amount of personal records from his wife, Edith M. Gardiner.

Custodial History:

Material was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives on February 26, 1985 by the Canadian Legion per Max Bronnum. Materials were accessioned in 1987, separating archival materials (1986.051) from artifacts (1986.065).

Notes:

Source of supplied title: Title based on contents of fonds.

Arrangement: State of the records during processing in 2018 did not indicate any prior or original arrangement, so folder arrangement and order were maintained. Photographs related specifically to Kamloops (file 1986.051.017 and album 1986.051.018) were removed from the body of records and stored elsewhere by previous archivists, and thus were placed at the end of the materials during processing when all records were reunited.

Access restrictions: No restrictions on access. The archivist reserves the right to restrict access to any fragile material for preservation purposes.
