Myles Bridge Hopkinson fonds. — 1923-2008. — 0.21 m of textual records and graphic material.

Scope and content

This fonds consists of the personal records of Myles Bridge Hopkinson (1921-2008), long-time rancher at Meadow Creek, B.C. Records in this fonds include 11 of his personal diaries (1938-1983) ranging from his early school days to the years he spent as a rancher in B.C.; personal documents and certificates documenting the lives of both Myles Hopkinson and his first wife, Murial Tainsh; an appraisal report of his ranch conducted in 1980; publications relating to ranching in the Kamloops area and the Southern Interior of B.C.; and a single photograph taken of Hopkinson in the mid-1970s.
