Title: Kamloops Sailing Club fonds

Dates of Creation: 1968-1985

Physical Description: 0.5 cm of textual records and 3 photographs

Administrative History:

The Kamloops Sailing Club was established in Blind Bay, B.C. (on Shuswap Lake) as the **Blind Bay Sailing Club** in 1961, with the purpose of promoting sailing activities in the area. In 1967 the club was renamed the **Kamloops Sailing Club**, and continues to host and participate in local and regional sailing events, training, and competitions predominantly on Shuswap Lake. 1970 saw the club move to Sorrento, but in 1972 they had established a base of operations from Sportsmans' Resort back in Blind Bay. That year also saw the club join forces with the Kamloops Sabot Fleet, which had been chartered in 1968. 1973 saw the club go largely dormant, with small turnout for local competitions, and in 1974 the club was reorganized, a formal constitution was written, and the club was incorporated under the Societies' Act in 1975. From 1976 to 1979 the club operated out of Magna Bay, after which point they had no permanent headquarters but continued to host and participate in sailing events in the area. The club later gained a more permanent leased base on Nicola Lake, and was renamed the **Kamloops Sailing Association**.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records related to the Kamloops Sailing Club (later Kamloops Sailing Association). Records include charters, certificates of incorporation, and membership information for the club; clippings; photographs; and reports.

Custodial History:

Accessions 1982.103 and 2018.144 were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives by Tony Embleton on December 15, 1982 and at an unknown date, respectively. Embleton was a former Commodore for the Kamloops Sailing Club. Accession 1982.103 was previously placed in the Vertical Files collection, and was brought together with accession 2018.144 to form a distinct collection during processing in 2020.
