Biographical Sketch:

Roland Arthur Chute was born on September 5, 1877 in Kentville, Nova Scotia, the son of Zenas Eliakim Chute and Ella Sarah Potter. Chute worked with the Dominion Atlantic Railroad and the Canadian Pacific Railroad as a young man, working the harvesting route towards western Canada. In 1905 Chute arrived in Kamloops, and began working odd jobs including running a trap line and as a hand logger. Chute was hired by Mary Spencer in June 1906 to work as her photographic assistant after her success in chronicling the trial of Bill Miner for the Vancouver Daily Province newspaper. When Spencer closed her successful studio in 1909 to move to Summerland with her sister, Chute would purchase the remainder of her photographic equipment that did not get sold (along with the studio) to Lena Walker of Walker Studio. It is unclear what Chute was employed with for the following two years, but he began working for the B.C. Telephone Company in 1911 as an assistant in the Kamloops office. Chute was promoted to manager of the branch in 1915 after manager H. Rolston enlisted to serve during World War I. In 1924 Chute was offered a position in the Vancouver office of the company, and his family would move there for the remainder of his life. Chute was married to Jemima (Mina) Clarke in Kamloops, B.C. on September 23, 1913, and the couple would have two sons (Joseph [Joe] Arthur and Raymond Clarke) and one daughter (Ella Grace). Roland Arthur Chute died on January 12, 1959 in Vancouver, B.C.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of photographic material (glass plate negatives and prints) predominantly created by the photography studio of Mary Spencer during Roland Chute's employment (1906-1909). A small amount of contemporary photographs from other local photography studios (Walker Studio, Scales Studio, and unknown) are also contained in the fonds, as well as digitally reproduced copies of many of the Mary Spencer Studio photographs created by donor Joe Chute. Fonds also contains a yearbook from Kamloops High School from 1926.
