## Biographical Sketch:

Ernst (Ernest) P. Salle was born in January 1872. Salle emigrated from Germany to Canada in 1912, settling with his family in Chinook Cove, B.C. to take up farming. He was married to Erna Scherming, with whom he had three sons (Volkemar, W.A., and Hans) and two daughters (Emma Ulli and Inge). After the death of his wife in 1948 Salle moved to Darfield, B.C. to live with his daughter Emma. Ernst P. Salle died on May 24, 1971 at the Royal Inland Hospital in Kamloops, B.C. at the age of 99.

Erna Salle (nee Scherming) was born on December 17, 1875 in Germany. She was married to Ernst P. Salle, with whom she had three sons (Volkemar, W.A., and Hans) and two daughters (Emma Ulli and Inge). The family emigrated to Canada from Germany in 1912, and settled in Chinook Cove, B.C. Erna Salle (nee Scherming) died on February 3, 1948 at the Royal Inland Hospital in Kamloops, B.C. at the age of 72.

### **Scope and Content:**

Fonds consists of predominantly of records related to the Salle family's farming activities in Chinook Cove, B.C. and contains many agricultural and animal husbandry publications. Fonds also contains a small amount of material related to the Salle family's experiences as German immigrants during the First and Second World Wars, including registration board records, a certificate of parole, and ration books. Included are also a small amount of materials related to social and community events, promotional items, and two photographs of local ferries.
