### Biographical Sketch:

**Stanley Josiah Pearse** was born on January 8, 1864 in London, England, the son of Josiah Robert and Maria Charlotte Pearse. He came to British Columbia around 1882, along with his six brothers, and for a time lived in Victoria, B.C. Pearse then travelled to the interior of the province to learn about farming, and worked at various farms throughout the province. On June 14, 1911 he married Margaret Jane McLean at Revelstoke, B.C. He then moved to Westwold, B.C. to establish a farm, and to live near his twin brother Leslie R. Pearse, a land surveyor who had settled in the area around 1884. Pearse was also interested in creative endeavors and taught himself to play the violin and to build radios, and was well known for his painting and fine woodworking skills. Stanley Josiah Pearse died on January 8, 1941 in Kamloops, B.C. at age 77.

### Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of correspondence to Stanley J. and Mrs. Pearse and a membership card for the British Columbia Honey Producers' Association.

### Custodial History:

No donor information is available for accession 0.3022. Records were formerly placed in the Vertical Files collection, and were reprocessed as a distinct fonds in 2020.
