Biographical Sketch:

Jack Ratcliffe lived in Kamloops for 17 years. He worked as manager of Buckerfield's and was active in community organizations, serving as president of the Rotary Club, the Kamloops and District Board of Trade, and the Kamloops and District Boy Scout's Council. He also participated in the 1947 establishment of the Trans-Canada Highway System Association (later the Trans Canada Yellowhead Highway Association). Ratcliffe died in 1961.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of correspondence, reports, clippings, and speeches resulting from Ratcliffe's activities with the Kamloops and District Board of Trade and the Kamloops and District Boy Scout's Council. Fonds also includes 2 maps.

Custodial History:

Collection was donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives in 1962 by D.A. Arnott. Maps and photographs which were originally donated with these materials were removed by former archivists and places in the Map Collection and Photograph Collection respectively.
