Scope and Content:

Collection consists of oral histories and transcripts collected and compiled by the Squam Bay Historical Society to document residents past and present of the area around Squam Bay. Collection also included two oral histories and transcripts collected and compiled by the Barriere Museum from the same area.

Custodial History:

No accession information is available for this collection. It is assumed that materials were donated to the Kamloops Museum and Archives shortly after their collection in 2000, directly from the Squam Bay Historical Society.
