Administrative History:

The Senior Citizen's Association of B.C., North Kamloops Branch #25 held its inaugural meeting at Mount Paul United Church on September 29, 1954, led by President J.F. Shook. Prior to 1954 an informal social club for seniors had been formed by members of Mount Paul United Church, and after meeting with the President of the newly formed Senior Citizen's Association of B.C., G.N. Edwards, the group decided to join the provincial organization and became Branch #25. Like the provincial organization, Branch #25's mandate was to advocate for Kamloops senior citizens on a local level, provide information and resources about services for seniors, and to coordinate with other regional groups towards projects which would benefit and support senior citizens. Branch #25's early meetings were held at members' homes, and many of their activities centred around hosting bazaars, rummage sales, teas, and raffles to fundraise towards their various projects. One of the group's early major initiatives was to build a home for the elderly, a project that was initially led by a Ladies' Auxiliary sub-committee who conducted surveys through the local Women's Institutes to further understand local interest and needs. In 1965 the North Kamloops Council bought property on Royal Avenue, which opened three years later as Thrupp Manor, a senior's care facility and long term care home. By 1964 Branch #25 was looking for new space to host their meetings and events, and briefly rented out the Moose Hall before settling into quarters at the North Kamloops Elk's Hall. In 1967 the branch played host to the annual convention of the Senior Citizen's Association of B.C. at Stockmen's Motel downtown. During the 1970s the group would become more involved in the wider community, attending many community events such as the Fall Fair and the New Horizons Program Festival, and sponsoring activities for seniors such as bus trips and picnics out of town and the annual Christmas Lights tour. From 1978 meetings and activities were held at the newly constructed Parkview Activity Centre. The group would continue their community activities and advocacy work until ca. 2002 when they disbanded.

Scope and Content:

Fonds consists of records generated and collected by the Senior Citizen's Association of B.C., North Kamloops Branch #25. Records include financial records, convention attendance materials, essays on the history of Branch #25, newsletters, constitution and by-laws, meeting minutes, correspondence, charity work materials, lists of members, a guest book, general news releases and publications related to senior citizens, calendars, newspaper clippings, two photograph albums, a proclamation from Seniors Week 2000, and a scrapbook.
