William B. Bailey and Company was a storage and forwarding agency headquartered in Ashcroft, B.C., which served the Cariboo region. The company was operated by William B. Bailey, who was also business partners with Oliver Harvey in similar enterprises in Ashcroft and Enderby.

Fonds consists of two books of waybills, one Day Book, and one Journal for William B. Bailey and Company.
